I/we agree to handle, pack, process, and move regulated articles in accordance with applicable plant quarantines; use all stamps and labels in accordance with instructions; maintain and offer for inspection such records as may be required; and abide by the following stipulations:

- All plants are to be grown under an approved pest management program to ensure freedom from actionable plant pests.
- Ensure that plants meet the requirements outlined in Arizona's Administrative Code R3-4-203(D)(2)(b) to ensure freedom from actionable nematode pests. Wholesale trays or plugs must be received at an Arizona-approved holding area. Unrooted cuttings and mail-order plant shipments are exempt from the holding area requirement.
- Ensure that shipments of plants are certified in accordance with the Imported Fire ant Quarantine (7 CFR § 301.81) and the Domestic Japanese Beetle Harmonization Plan.
- Plants regulated under any other Arizona Administrative Code, including R3-4-220 Citrus Nursery Stock Pests or R3-4-241 Palm Pests, are prohibited.
- Ensure that staff at each approved nursery are trained and capable of detecting plant pests.
- Quarterly inspections will be conducted by a Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services/Division of Plant Industry (FDACS/DPI) inspector to verify compliance with these conditions.
- Maintain a list of Arizona customers on file for no less than 1 calendar year from invoice date and make records available to the Arizona Department of Agriculture and FDACS upon request.
- Noncompliance with the above conditions will void this agreement, and all stamps must be returned to FDACS/DPI.
- Bills of lading or invoices accompanying all shipments shall include:
 - The names and addresses of the shipper and receiver.
 - The common and botanical name and quantity of plants in the shipment.
 - A statement of origin.
 - An approved stamp or label certifying participation in this agreement.
